



Solar & Storage Summit Health and Safety Protocols

The Florida Solar Energy Industries Association (FlaSEIA) is excited to host the 2021 Florida Solar & Storage Summit. We are committed to hosting an event where the solar industry can come together safely and effectively conduct business.

We are implementing numerous procedures which will be followed during the event.

Prior to arriving at the Summit

- Pre-register by using the online portal, returning the PDF registration form or calling the FlaSEIA office (407-339-2010). This will reduce your time in the registration area.
- Please pack a face mask; this is required at all times.
- Complete a health self-assessment. Are you experiencing any symptoms? If you feel sick, please stay home. Refer to the CDC website for information about COVID related symptoms

Registration Area

- Plan to arrive at the hotel at least 30 minutes prior to the event start time to allow for walking from the parking lot, badge pick up and time to get to your seat.
- Have your registration confirmation printed or easily accessible on your phone.
- Stanchions and floor markings will remind you to keep a safe distance.

While at the Summit

- Face coverings are required inside the Hyatt Regency Grand Cypress. Individuals will be required to wear a mask. If you arrive without a mask, FlaSEIA has masks available at no charge.
- Wash your hands often, cover your cough or sneeze.
- Hand sanitizer stations will be available throughout the public spaces. FlaSEIA will have hand sanitizer available throughout the meeting space and in the classroom areas.
- Please refrain from handshakes and hugs.
- Seating areas will be properly distanced and limited seats will be at each table.

Meeting Space

- We have arranged for one way entrances and exits.
- Exhibitors are encouraged to limit booth personnel to 2 people at any given time.
- If taking classes for Florida continuing education credit, bring your photo ID (driver's license) to present to the classroom monitor.
- Capacity will be limited and seats will be set according to CDC and Orange County spacing requirement.
